Estonia / Tunisia / UK – UN @ 75 Conference Programme



In partnership with the governments of Estonia & Tunisia, SSCW, the Anna Lindh Foundation and others, PCI is leading a Euro-Med contribution to the UN's Global Conversation, focussing on 4 x key elements of the UN's Sustainable Development Goals:

- **<u>Peace</u>**: Enabling the UN to be a more effective peace-builder / peace-keeper, through conflict transformation, peace-keeping forces, Intercultural dialogue and other means;
- <u>Sustainability</u>: Achieving Sustainable Economic Growth and creating jobs for youth through investing in Green Growth and Resource Efficiency;
- Human Rights and Digital Protection: Creating a Human Rights / Digital protection regime fit for 21st Century realities;
- <u>Climate Change</u>: halting and reversing global heating by transforming global consumption patterns and investing in clean energy;

The initiative began with a 3-day Conference in Talinn, Estonia from 21-23 February which was opened by HE Herman Quarles Ufford, part of the UN Secretary-General's team assigned to promoting the UN's 75th Anniversary. It is scheduled to continue with a Drafting Session / Experts Meeting in Sousse, Tunisia, May 28-31 (*to finalise our contribution to the UN Global Conversation*) – to a worldwide promotion of the UN Secretary General's speech to the UN General Assembly (*where he draws together the key ideas raised in the Global Conversation*) – to a Conference on Implementation of both the SG's ideas and the ideas crafted in Estonia and Tunisia to be held in Tallinn, 8 – 11 October 2020. A final meeting may be held in London in January 2021 to coincide with the Secretary General's visit on January 10th – the 75th Anniversary of the Opening of the 1st UN General Assembly in Westminster's Central Hall.
