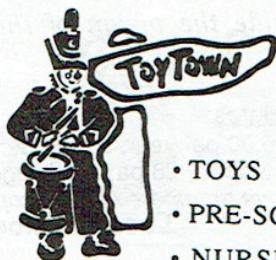

We just can't hear our planet cry -

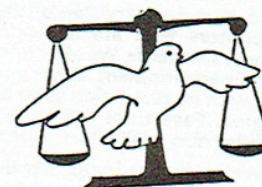
We want this world to survive for ever

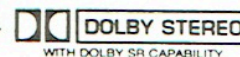
